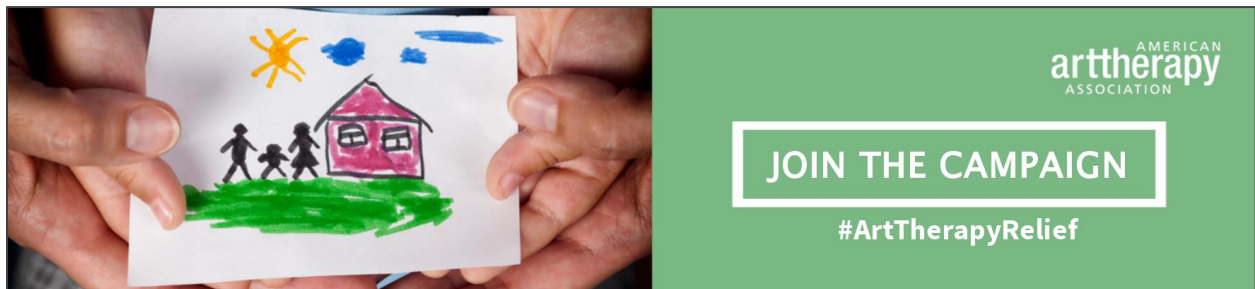


# Only a Few Weeks Left to Support #ArtTherapyRelief for Our Communities
