About the ICSC'15 Conference

Abstracts are now being accepted for the Canadian Society for Civil Engineering **5th International / 11th Construction Specialty Conference (ICSC15)**. ICSC'15, the 5th international conference and 11th Canadian conference provides an opportunity for researchers and practitioners from North America and around the world to share the most recent innovations and developments in the construction industry. This conference will be held in partnership with the American Society of Civil Engineers' Construction Institute (Construction Research Congress - CRC), the US Construction Industry Institute, and the UK Association of Researchers in Construction Management (ARCOM). The conference will be held from June 8-10, 2015 at the University of British Columbia's (UBC) Vancouver campus, overlooking beautiful Howe Sound in Vancouver, Canada. UBC is only 2 hours away from Whistler B.C., which, with Vancouver, was the site of the 2010 Winter Olympics, and a similar distance across the waters of Georgia Strait from Victoria on Vancouver Island, Canada's west coast jewel.

Conference accommodation is available on the UBC campus or in Vancouver's city centre (30 minutes from campus by public transport).

UBC is also the location of EESD'15-the 7th International Conference on Engineering Education for Sustainable Development, held from June 9 to 12, 2015. Also, ASEE 2015, The American Society for Engineering Education Annual Conference, Seattle, USA (about 4 hours from Vancouver), June 15-17, 2015. Your participation in the conference is eagerly anticipated and essential to the success of the event.

Invitation for Abstract Submissions

Contributions should be reflective and analytical, not mere descriptions of performed activities. The conference benefits greatly from industry participation with the sharing of innovative approaches and solutions to engineering problems through case studies. We particularly welcome submissions from industry in the form of case studies.

Abstracts, written in English or French and no longer than 400 words and should summarize the following:

1. Introduction to the subject area,
2. Objectives,
3. Methodology/approach
4. Findings and contributions

Upon notification to authors of abstract acceptance, full papers to a maximum of 10 pages or a case study in the form of an extended abstract of four (4) pages must be submitted by **February 1st, 2015** for peer review. At least one author must register for the conference, attend, and present the paper or case study. Selected conference authors will be invited to expand their papers for consideration for the Canadian Journal of Civil Engineering, Special Issue in Construction Engineering and Management.
