What is CREU?

CREU is a web-based crowdfunding platform for undergraduate research that can be found at <http://creu.tilt.com>. Potential research projects from any nonprofit two or four year US institution can be posted to the site in order to accept donations.

What makes CREU different from other crowdfunding sites?

- It is dedicated exclusively to undergraduate research.
- All projects are reviewed by an independent expert before posting.
- It provides a grant-type experience for undergraduates.
- No fees are charged to campaigners.
- It allows matching funds.
- Money can be raised for supplies, equipment, travel, housing, and student stipends.
