

KSWEBIZ TRAININGS

The Kansas Immunization Registry, also referred to as KWebIZ, is the statewide immunization registry. It is a web-based centralized birth to death database that maintains complete, accurate, and secure immunization records for all Kansas residents.

The purpose of KWebIZ is to consolidate immunization information among health care professionals, assure adequate immunization levels, and avoid unnecessary immunizations. Registry data is used by healthcare professionals to: monitor the immunization status of children and adults; assure compliance with state statutes on immunization requirements for individuals; identify geographic areas at high risk due to low immunization rates; and document/assess vaccination coverage during disease outbreaks.

KWebIZ will be holding online trainings the following dates and times. Participation is encouraged for new users, inventory managers and all registry users. These trainings are designed for users that directly access the registry, which does not include interface users – training calls for those users will be held at different times.
