NENA's Industry Collaboration Events (ICE) provide the opportunity for vendors to test their NG9-1-1 standard interfaces against equipment from other vendors. As such, only vendors may participate.
Almost every element in NENA's "13" NG9-1-1 architecture is required to log event data for every call it is involved with. ICE 8 will test this event logging functionality, along with call media recording functionality.
The interfaces for these requirements will be tested at ICE 8. Vendors of these elements are strongly encouraged to test these interfaces at the event. If you wish to participate, respond no later than Jan. 31, 2013.
