“Effective Compliance Program: How is Law Enforcement Evaluating Your Efforts?”

In February 2017, the U.S. Department of Justice published guidance describing specific factors that prosecutors should consider when conducting an investigation of a corporate entity in order to determine whether to bring criminal charges. These factors, commonly known as the “Filip Factors,” include “the existence and effectiveness of the corporation’s preexisting compliance program” and the corporation’s remedial efforts “to implement an effective corporate compliance program or to improve an existing one.” Notably, the Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Inspector General (OIG), followed-up in March 2017 with a list of questions that health care providers can use to evaluate the effectiveness of their organization's compliance program. What should AAHAM members conclude from these developments? Simply put, law enforcement investigators and prosecutors are serious about holding an organization and its management accountable for its actions. Compliance Programs that are nothing more than "paper tigers" will not only fail to protect an organization, such programs may affirmatively expose an organization and its management to administrative, civil and / or criminal liability if improper conduct occurs. During this session, we will examine what the government expects and the steps you can take to better ensure that your health care organization is complying with applicable statutory and regulatory requirements.

Objectives:

1. Participants will learn about the state of the government's current health care fraud enforcement efforts.
2. Participants will learn how to evaluate the effectiveness of their organization's Compliance Program.
3. Participants will cover the factors considered by DOJ when deciding whether or not to prosecute a health care provider organization (or members of its management) for improper conduct.
4. Participants will learn how to best respond when an overpayment to a federal or state health care program has been identified.
5. Participants will learn about Best Practices when implementing an effective Compliance Program for your organization.
