FYI: Recent examples of USMLE actions against individuals found to have engaged in irregular behavior

This link to the USMLE Announcements page was forwarded as an FYI. It lists examples of the types of behaviors that may result in disciplinary action against students. Particularly germane to my workplace were cases involving students communicating about specific test items and failure to follow test center instructions. They also note that such actions, if found guilty, may result in barring access to USMLE for up to three years. During assessments at my institution, students confirm adherence to our Honor Code that covers many of not all of the situations described by the USMLE.
