



Awards, State of the Association, and CDT Update Comprise Closing Session

One of the highlights each year of the MISAC Annual Conference is the final general session when awards are handed out, members receive a MISAC progress report and a representative of the California Department of Technology gives an update of things happening at CDT. Kicking off this session will be the newly appointed Deputy State CIO and CDT Chief Deputy Director Russ Nichols who will talk about happenings at the California Department of Technology. This year, twenty-six member agencies applied for the Excellence and Achievement awards.
